AWARDS CRITERIA FOR 2011 NATIONAL CONFERENCE

AWARDS – Individuals, law enforcement / public safety agencies, and associations are the heart of successful academies and alumni groups. We would like to recognize them by allowing attendees to nominate for the following awards.

- **Citizens Police Academy Coordinator for 2011**

This individual will be recognized for their outstanding dedication and contributions to the overall success of a Citizens Police Academy program.

- **Citizens Police Academy Alumni Member for 2011**

This individual will be recognized for their outstanding dedication and contributions to the overall success of a Citizens Police Academy Alumni organization.

- **Law Enforcement Agency for 2011**

This award recognizes a public safety agency (police department, sheriff's department, etc.) for outstanding dedication in supporting and promoting the Citizens Police Academy concept. This may include developing a successful academy program and conducting annual academies that allow citizens to become familiar with the daily operations of their local, county, state, or federal public safety agencies.
